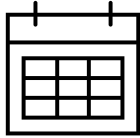

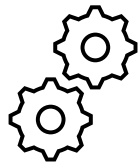

No official language test is required, but we strongly advise international exchange students to make sure that their language skills will allow them to fully take part in all academic activities.

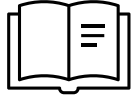

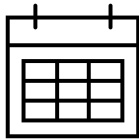

Fall Term: 14 September – last week of January

Teaching: 12 weeks, starting from mid- September

Winter exam session: from 2 January until 25 January

Spring Term: 1 February – 30 June

Integration weeks (fall) and days (spring)



Organized every year before the beginning of the fall term (first two weeks of September), the orientation weeks consist of French or English as a second language courses (worth 3 ECTS credits) and cultural and social activities to facilitate the integration of international students.

A shorter event (without language classes) is organized during three days in early February.

Cost of living



Housing: approximately 365 Euros/month for university-managed housing (housing offered by the private market is about 200 Euros more expensive)

Living expenses: approximately 600-700 Euros/month
